

## How to get from the Frankfurt Airport to Augsburg?

Look for the long-distance train station in terminal AIRail close to Terminal 1. The trains arrive at and leave from platforms 4 -7.

You can take a direct train to Augsburg from this station. The ride with an ICE takes approximately 3 hours. Look for connections and prices at [www.bahn.de](http://www.bahn.de).

The following service and information points are available at the Frankfurt Airport:

### **The Travel Center of the German Railway (DB Reisezentrum)**

At the Travel Center, you can ask for information or make a reservation. It is also possible to buy tickets for the long-distance trains here. The Travel Center is located in Terminal 1, Section B, Level 0 (Arrivals) and in Terminal AIRail on Level 3.

### **The DB Service Point "unterm Flughafen"**

Beside the Travel Center, you can also get information at the DB Service Point. Go there if you have questions about trains, connections, delays, the city of Frankfurt, hotels and public transit. The DB Service Point is located in Terminal 1, Section B, Level 0 (Arrivals).

Usually, it is necessary to go direction Königsplatz from the Main station.

In order to get there, leave the Main station direction Innenstadt, pass a water fountain in front of the station and continue to the tram stop. Take tram Nr. 3 direction „Inninger Straße“. The next stop is Königsplatz.

You have a choice of different means of transportation at Königsplatz. One of them is going to bring you to your new home.
