

How to get from the Munich Airport (MUC) to Augsburg?

- Take the „S-Bahn“ S8/S1 direction München Innenstadt / Hauptbahnhof from the Airport (approx. 40 min.)
- Get off at München Hauptbahnhof.
- Leave the S-Bahn area and follow the **DB** signs (German Railway).
- Look for a train going to Augsburg on the departures board in the large lobby of the Main railway station (in the middle of the station opposite platforms 15 -17) or ask at the information counter.
- Trains between Munich and Augsburg commute every hour. The last one leaves for Augsburg at approximately 0 am.
- Make sure that the train really does go to Augsburg at the information board on the particular platform once more!
- Get off at Augsburg Hauptbahnhof.
- Usually, it is necessary to go direction Königsplatz from the Main station.
- In order to get there, leave the Main station direction Innenstadt, pass a water fountain in front of the station and continue to the tram stop. Take tram Nr. 3 direction „Inninger Straße“. The next stop is Königsplatz.
- You have a choice of different means of transportation at Königsplatz. One of them is going to bring you to your new home.

Tips:

What ticket shall you buy?

- The easiest option is to buy the „Bayern Single Ticket“. It is valid for the whole ride from the Airport to your place of stay in Augsburg (including the S-Bahn in Munich and the public transit in Augsburg) and it costs only € 19,-.
- !!! But watch out!!! You may only take the following trains from Munich to Augsburg: RE, RB and IRE. It is important that you do not take an IC or ICE!!!
- If you travel to Augsburg together with other people, you can buy the „Bayern Ticket“. It costs € 27,- and is valid for 5 people.
- The ICE trains commute every hour also at night, however, they are more expensive.

It is the easiest to buy the ticket at a counter, for example at the counters of the German Railway at the Airport. To find them, follow the signs or ask at an information desk.

It is a good idea to take a cab from the Main station in Augsburg. It is not expensive and you will have no problem carrying your luggage.
